FPPC Case No. 12/589; Rosanne Barr, Rosanne Barr for President 2012

Dear Ms. Barr:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”). As you may be aware, the Commission received an anonymous complaint concerning two mass mailings sent on or about of May 30, 2012 and May 31, 2012, purportedly by “Rosanne Barr for President 2012,” both of which advocated the election of Green Party candidates for the Los Angeles County Council, in the June 5, 2012 primary. One mailer advocated electing Bob Kennech, Linda J. Albertano, John Wenger and Michael Ian Sachs, and the second advocated Will Yaeger, Glenn Hopkins, and S. Deacon Alexander. Specifically, the complaint alleged violations of the sender identification provisions and independent expenditure committee filing requirements of the Act. The Commission has decided to close this case without further action.

After a full investigation, we found insufficient evidence to indicate that you or your committee, Rosanne Barr for President 2012, authorized, produced, or distributed the mailers.
