Warning Letter Re: FPPC No. 12/939: Elect Noguez Committee; John "Juan" Noguez; and Martha Castaneda, Treasurer

Dear Mr. Noguez and Ms. Castaneda:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "FPPC") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act"),¹ found in Government Code section 81000, et seq. This letter is the result of a pro-active investigation begun against you by the FPPC that alleged you may have failed to disclose the true source of a contribution. We are closing this matter with a warning letter.

The FPPC has completed its investigation of the facts in this case. Specifically, the FPPC found that the occupation and employer information for a contribution received from Andrew Stephens was not properly disclosed.

Specifically, Section 84211(f)(4) requires that whenever the cumulative amount of contributions of \$100 or more is received from a person, the occupation and employer information is required to be disclosed.
