Re: Case Closure – FPPC No. 13/076, O'Day Consultants, Inc.

Dear Mr. O'Day:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "FPPC") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act"),¹ found in Government Code section 81000, et seq. The FPPC initiated an investigation as the result of an informal complaint we received alleging that O'Day Consultant, Inc. ("O'Day") made campaign contributions to Encinitas City Council Member Jerome Stocks in November of 2009 in the name of its employees rather than its own name in violation of Section 84301 of the Act.

The FPPC has completed its investigation of the facts in this case. The FPPC did not find evidence that O'Day was the true source of campaign contributions made by various O'Day employees to Jerome Stock's campaign in 2009. That being the case, the FPPC found no evidence that O'Day violated the Act.

Since we have determined that O'Day did not violate the Act, we are closing this matter. But information will be retained and may be considered should an enforcement action result from future conduct or newly discovered information. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act can result in an enforcement action against you and penalties of up to \$5,000 per violation.
