As you are aware, the Fair Political Practices Commission ("Commission") initiated an investigation regarding the allegation that you may violated the gift limit and conflict-of-interest provisions of the Political Reform Act ("Act").¹ As a result of our investigation and in light of the evidence that you have recently provided, the Enforcement Division has determined that there is insufficient evidence to find that you violated the Act in this particular circumstance. Therefore, we have decided to close this matter and withdraw our request for an administrative hearing.
