The Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”)¹. The Commission’s Enforcement Division conducted an investigation into allegations that Cotati Neighbors for Measure G failed to accurately disclose its expenditures during the first half of 2014 in violation of Section 84211. The Enforcement Division’s investigation did not find sufficient evidence to determine that the committee violated the Act. As a result, we are closing this matter without any further action.
