**Re: Closure Letter  
FPPC No. 12/407: Cameron Hamilton**

Dear Mr. Hamilton:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act. As you are aware, the Commission received a complaint against you concerning the gift limits provisions of the Act. Specifically, the complaint alleged that you received several tickets and meal vouchers from an Indian Casino to a concert held at the casino in April 2011, that the total value of the concert tickets was in excess of \$500, and that you failed to disclose these gifts in your 2011 annual statement of economic interests.

After a full investigation, the Enforcement Division has found insufficient evidence to find a violation of the Act. Our investigation revealed that you did not receive tickets and meal vouchers from the Casino, and you did not accept a gift over the limits from the Casino. Additionally, you were not required to disclose the tickets and meal vouchers as behested payments because the VIP package you requested from the Casino for the four VIP guests (a kidney donor and spouse, and the kidney recipient and spouse) did not reach the Act's \$5,000 threshold. Therefore, we have closed our file in this matter.
