**RE: In the Matter of ActBlue California and Erin Hill, Treasurer; FPPC No. 14/323**

Dear Mr. Gold:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”),<sup>1</sup> found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. This letter is in response to an audit report referred to us by the Franchise Tax Board. The audit covered the period January 1, 2009, through December 31, 2010.

Our investigation found that ActBlue California and its treasurer Erin Hill (collectively “Respondents”) over-reported the total amount of payments ActBlue California received during the January 1 through March 17, 2010, and the March 18 through May 22, 2010, reporting periods.

However, our investigation also found that the over-reporting was inadvertent, that Respondents addressed the error that caused the over-reporting, and that Respondents did not over-report payments received on any other campaign statement they filed for the audit period. We are therefore closing this case with this letter.
