Advisory Letter Re: FPPC No. <sup>11</sup>10/0444; DeAndre Valencia, Respondent

Dear Mr. Valencia:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the Act) found in Government Code Section 81000, et seq. We recently received a sworn complaint concerning your failure to accurately report your interest in your business, Valencia & Associates.

In response to our letter to you concerning the matter, you amended your Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) to correctly report your business on Schedule A-2 of the statement. Previously, this information was contained on both Schedule A-2 and on Schedule C of the statement. In a telephone conversation with you, I advised that with respect to your business, it is only necessary that it be reported on Schedule A-2. Based on your immediate response to our letter to correct this, we have decided to close this matter.
