The Fair Political Practices Commission ("Commission") considered allegations made regarding the campaign reporting and bank account provisions of the Political Reform Act ("Act")¹ pertaining to your interaction with Berkeley Tenants United for Fairness, a slate mailer organization and alleged recipient committee. Concurrently, the Berkeley Fair Campaign Practices Commission investigated this matter and reached a settlement agreement regarding these allegations, which was adopted at their May 16, 2013 Commission meeting.
