Dear Mr. Campbell:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act")<sup>1</sup>. As you are aware, the Commission initiated an investigation into whether you violated the Act's conflicts of interest provisions specified in Government Code Section 87100 based on findings published in the Orange County Grand Jury Report-CalOptima.

After a full investigation, the Enforcement Division has found insufficient evidence to establish a violation of the Act. More specifically, the Enforcement Division reviewed the meetings and minutes of the Orange County Board of Supervisors and determined that the allegations were too vague to establish that you had a conflict of interest in violation of Section 87100.
