Dear Mr. Ryanerson:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "FPPC") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act"),<sup>1</sup> found in Government Code section 81000, et seq. This letter is in response to a sworn complaint filed against you that alleged you were in violation of the Act's campaign reporting disclosure requirements. Specifically, the complaint alleged Freepb failed to file campaign disclosure reports for contributions received and expenditures made in 2008, and failed to file a major donor report for contributions made of \$10,000 or more in 2008.

The FPPC has completed its investigation of the facts in this case. Specifically, the FPPC found that you did file campaign disclosure statements in 2008 disclosing contributions and expenditures received. You were further not required to file a major donor committee statement because you had already formed Freepb as a primarily formed ballot measure committee and disclosed your expenditures and contributions through that committee.

The Commission publishes forms and manuals to facilitate compliance with the provisions of the Act and provides guidance regarding your obligations over the telephone and through written advice.
