Warning Letter Re: FPPC No. 15/1389; Mary Mariscal

Dear Ms. Mariscal:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a referral from the Commission's Technical Assistance Division regarding your failure to file your 2014 Annual Statement of Economic Interests ("SEI").

Section 87200 of the Act requires certain public officials to disclose reportable interests. Every person who is elected shall then file a statement within 30 days after assuming office. Throughout the duration of holding that office, he or she shall file an annual statement at the time specified by Commission regulations. Lastly, every person who leaves office shall file within 30 days of leaving office.

You violated the Act because you failed to file your 2014 Annual SEI by the April 1, 2015 deadline. Because you filed your 2014 Annual SEI, you are no longer in office, and you do not have an enforcement history, the Enforcement Division has decided to close this case with a warning letter.

This letter serves as a written warning. The information in this matter will be retained and may be considered should an enforcement action become necessary based on newly discovered information or future conduct. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act in the future will result in monetary penalties of up to \$5,000 for each violation.

A warning letter is an Enforcement Division case resolution without administrative prosecution or fine. However, the warning letter resolution does not provide you with the opportunity for a probable cause hearing or hearing before an Administrative Law Judge or the Fair Political Practices Commission. If you wish to avail yourself of these proceedings by requesting that your case proceed with prosecution rather than a warning, please notify us within

ten (10) days from the date of this letter. Upon this notification, the Enforcement Division will rescind this warning letter and proceed with administrative prosecution of this case. If we do not receive such notification, this warning letter will be posted on the Commission's website ten (10) days from the date of this letter.
