Advisory Letter Re: FPPC No. 11/027; Leon Beauchman, Respondent

Dear Mr. Beauchman:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the Act) found in Government Code Section 81000, et seq. We received a Statement of Economic Interest non-filer referral from the Santa Clara County Clerk concerning your failure to file your 2010 Annual Statement of Economic Interests.

In response to our letter to you concerning the matter, you phoned and informed me that you file a statement in your capacity as a member of the Santa Clara Board of Education. This information was confirmed by Santa Clara County. Please note that while a 2009 Annual Statement of Economic Interests was not required of you in your capacity as a member of the Juvenile Justice Systems Collaborative, the County has since made changes to the Conflict of Interest Code for the County and your disclosure for both agencies is no longer similar. You will be required in the future to complete a separate statement for both agencies, or alternatively, file an expanded statement to the Board of Education filing to include interests required by the Juvenile Justice Systems Collaborative.
