Dear Mr. Rodriguez:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "FPPC") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act"), found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. As you may know, the Enforcement Division of the FPPC has been investigating whether you timely filed your 2008 annual Statement of Economic Interests ("SEI"). After examining the information that you have provided, the Enforcement Division has decided to close its file on this matter without further enforcement action.

Under the Act, a designated employee, as defined in Section 82019, subdivision (a), of the Act and in the Los Angeles Unified School District's Conflict of Interest Code, is required to file an annual SEI by April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year that the employee remains in office. The Los Angeles Unified School District Ethics Officer stated that your SEI for the year 2008 was not received by the filing officer. However, when contacted, you provided evidence that your 2008 SEI was filed timely and have since filed a duplicate with the filing officer at our request. We advise all filers to request and maintain a copy of all date-stamped SEIs they file for their own records. The FPPC has completed a review of the foregoing allegation and closed this case with this advisory letter.
