Dear Mr. Bohr:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”) found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. As you know, the Enforcement Division of the Commission received a complaint regarding the conflict of interest provisions of the Act. After completing the investigation, the Commission has found no violation of the Act in this matter.

To prevent conflicts of interest in governmental decision making, Section 87100 prohibits state and local public officials from making, participating in making, or attempting to use their official positions to influence a governmental decision in which they know, or have reason to know, that they have a financial interest. Under Section 87103, a public official has a financial interest in a decision if it is reasonably foreseeable that the decision will have a material financial effect on a recognized economic interest of the official. The investigation did not reveal that you had a financial interest in Team Design and Construction, as alleged in the complaint. As a result, no violation of the Act occurred and this matter is now closed.
