FPPC No. 13/075: Ford Greene

Dear Mr. Greene:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ As you are aware, the Commission received a complaint alleging that you attempted to use your official position as a member of the San Anselmo (the "Town") Town Council to influence governmental decisions in which you had a disqualifying financial interest, in violation of Section 87100. Specifically, the complaint alleged that you attempted to influence decisions regarding a building permit application you had pending with the Town.

The Enforcement Division of the Commission has completed its investigation into the allegations and found that you contacted Town officials regarding decisions related to your application for a building permit. However, we also found that you only appeared before Town officials in the course of their prescribed governmental functions and solely to represent yourself on matters related to real property which you wholly owned. Therefore your conduct fell within the exception in Regulation 18702.4, subdivision (b), and was not a violation of Section 87100. Accordingly, we are closing this case with this letter.
