The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") was reviewing a matter concerning the City of Costa Mesa's failure to file a quarterly Report of Lobbyist Employer/ Report of Lobbyist Coalition (Form 635) disclosing all lobbying activity for the period of January 1, 2011 through March 31, 2011. After a review of this matter, we found no violation of the Political Reform Act because your lobbying firm, Sloat Higgins Jensen & Associates retroactively filed to delete your status as their employer and have thus eliminated your outstanding quarterly filing obligation. We appreciate your cooperation in our review of this matter and it is now considered closed.
