RE: Advisory Letter

Dear Mr. Carr:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”) found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. The Act requires candidates to file periodic campaign disclosure statements disclosing contributions received and expenditures made during specified periods of time. Once a committee ceases all activity, it may terminate its campaign filing obligations.

As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Commission received a sworn complaint against you alleging that you failed to file campaign statements in connection with your campaign activity for Stanton City Council.

With regard to that allegation, we found no evidence to indicate you are on the ballot in November for a city council position and the complainant failed to provide evidence to support that allegation.

However, it was noted that you have yet to terminate your campaign committee that you opened in 2002. In response to our communication to you, you acknowledged that the committee has been open for the past ten years’ has not been active in over six years and is running a negative balance in that it owes a debt to you for a loan you made to the committee previously. You also provided evidence that you have contacted the Commission’s advice line in the past for assistance in closing that committee.

At this time you should terminate your committee retroactively to the date your committee ceased all activity by filing a Campaign Disclosure Statement (Form 460) and a Statement of Organization (Form 410). The original Statement of Organization should

be filed directly with the Office of the Secretary of State and a copy of that form, along with an original Campaign Disclosure Statement must be filed with the Stanton City Clerk.

Since there is no evidence to support the allegation that you are campaigning for elective office, and the Orange County Registrar of Voter's website confirms that you are not a candidate for office in the City of Stanton, we are closing this matter.
