Dear Ms. Saunders:

The Fair Political Practices Commission ("Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act") found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. As you may be aware, the Commission was investigating whether you were in violation of the conflict of interest provisions of the Act because you allegedly received income from BFGC Architects, through your husband's interest in Pacific Management and Development, and then subsequently participated in a governmental decision involving BFGC Architects while a member of the Paso Robles Public Schools Board of Trustees.

We have determined that there is no evidence to find you violated the Act. As a result, we are closing this case with this letter.

The Commission publishes forms and manuals to facilitate compliance with the provisions of the Act and provides guidance regarding filing obligations over the telephone and through written advice.
