The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "FPPC") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. As you may know, the Enforcement Division of the FPPC has been determining whether your client, Renee Ramirez, had a conflict of interest from contributions received while running for the position of Orange County Clerk Recorder in the June 2010 election. After evaluating the facts and evidence, the Enforcement Division has decided to close its file on this matter without further enforcement action since Ms. Ramirez was not an "officer" as defined in Section 84308 and Regulation 18438.1, subdivision (d), so the prohibitions found in Section 84308 would not apply to her.
