The Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).<sup>1</sup> As you are aware, the Commission initiated an investigation regarding the allegation that David Potter may have violated the gift disclosure and gift limit provisions of the Act. After a review of his annual Statements of Economic Interests and other information provided by him regarding his trip to Ireland last year, the Commission has determined that no violation of the Act has occurred and is closing this matter.
