Advisory Letter Re: FPPC Case No. 13/952; Lodi Chamber of Commerce Political Action Committee (Sponsored by Lodi District Chamber of Commerce) and Pat Patrick, Treasurer

Dear Mr. Patrick:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ In response to a referral we received regarding you and your committee, Lodi Chamber of Commerce Political Action Committee Sponsored by Lodi District Chamber of Commerce ("committee"), alleging that you and the committee have violated the campaign reporting provisions of the Act, we write this letter to address the matter.

The referral from the City of Lodi identified that two campaign statements filed by the committee have discrepancies in the ending and subsequent beginning balances in violation of Section 84211, subdivision (e).

Statements:

7/1/09 – 12/31/09 Period Covered

\$2938.00 – Ending Balance

1/1/10 – 6/30/10 Period Covered

Each campaign statement is required, per Section 84211(e), to contain: “the balance of cash and cash equivalents on hand at the beginning and the end of the period covered by the campaign statement.” We are closing the case with this advisory letter to alert you of the Act’s requirement that the closing balance of one campaign statement must be the “cash on hand” for the next statement.
