Dear Mr. Maan:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”) found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. As you are aware, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission received a complaint regarding a robocall and a mass mailer that went out shortly before the November 2, 2010 election in Yuba City. The robocall and mass mailer contained express advocacy urging voters not to re-elect Kash Gill to the city council, and were identified as being paid for by the “Concerned Citizens for a Strong Yuba City.”

After a full investigation, the Enforcement Division has found insufficient evidence to establish that you violated the Act. The investigation was unable to establish the identity of the individual(s) responsible for the mailer and call. Therefore, we have closed our file in this matter.
