The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ As you are aware, the Commission proactively initiated an investigation against your client, the Kern County Democratic Central Committee concerning the failure to report the true source of contributions to the Sharon Quirk-Silva for Assembly 2012 campaign committee.

After a full investigation, the Enforcement Division has found insufficient evidence to establish that you failed to report the true source of contributions to this committee. Therefore, we have closed our investigation against you in this matter.

The Commission publishes forms and manuals to facilitate compliance with the provisions of the Act and provides guidance regarding filing obligations over the telephone and through written advice.
