Re: **Warning Letter**
FPPC No. 06/789; Improving Our Community, David Armenta, and Kevin
Armenta, Treasurer

Dear Mr. David Armenta and Mr. Kevin Armenta:

As you may know, the Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (the "FPPC") received a Franchise Tax Board (FTB) audit referral. Based on the evidence obtained from the FTB audit and our own investigation, we agree with the FTB audit report that the Improving Our Community, David Armenta, and Kevin Armenta violated the Political Reform Act (the "Act")¹ by: 1) failing to maintain adequate records to support the receipt of monetary contributions during the audit period, in violation of Government Code section 84104 and 2) failing to maintain invoices and receipts of the expenditures made, in violation of the Government Code section 84104.

However, we have decided to close this case. This letter serves as a written warning. The information in this matter will be retained and considered should an
