**Re: Warning Letter
FPPC No. 070285; Tracy Rice**

Dear Ms. Rice

The Fair Political Practices Commission (“Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”) found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. The Act requires that employees designated in their employer’s conflict of interest code file Statements of Economic Interests (Form 700) when they assume office, annually thereafter, and within 30 days of leaving their position.

The Enforcement Division of the Commission has determined that you failed to file an assuming office statement of economic interests by the June 16, 2005 deadline, and a leaving office statement of economic interests by the March 28, 2006, deadline regarding your position as a former Field Representative with the California State Assembly.

We have decided to close this case. Your failure to file the required statements is a violation of the Act. (Gov. Code § 87300.) This letter serves as a written warning. The information in this matter will be retained and may be considered should an enforcement action become necessary based on future conduct or newly discovered information.

You must immediately file these statements with the Commission’s Technical Assistance Division.

Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act in the future may result in an enforcement action against you, including monetary penalties of up to \$5,000 for each violation.

Although the Enforcement Division is not seeking a penalty in the current matter, you are still responsible for any late filing fees assessed by the Technical Assistance Division. (Gov. Code § 91013.)
