Dear Ms. Loisel:

The Fair Political Practices Commission ("Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act") found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. The Act requires that persons identified in Section 87200 file a Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) when they assume office, annually thereafter and within 30 days of leaving their position.

The Enforcement Division of the Commission has determined that you failed to file a combined Annual and Leaving Office Statement of Economic Interests with the County of Alameda within 30 days of leaving the Planning Commission in January of 2009, despite two notifications by our Technical Assistance Division.

However, since you were reappointed in June of 2009 and filed an Assuming Office Statement, we have decided to close this case. Your failure to file the required statement in January of 2009 is a violation of the Act. (Section 87204.) This letter serves as a written warning. The information in this matter will be retained and may be considered should an enforcement action become necessary based on future conduct or newly discovered information. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act in the future may result in an enforcement action against you, including monetary penalties of up to \$5,000 for each violation.

You will be contacted by the Commission's Technical Assistance Division shortly and instructed to make adjustments to the cover page of your statement.

Although the Enforcement Division is not seeking an administrative penalty in the current matter, you are still responsible for any late filing fine assessed by the Technical Assistance Division. (Section 91013.)

If you disagree with our determination that you violated the Act, please contact Jeanette Turvill in writing postmarked within 14 days of the date of this letter.
