**Re: Warning Letter
FPPC No. 090459; Barbie Boeger, Friends of Barbie Boeger**

Dear Ms. Boeger:

The Fair Political Practices Commission ("Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act") found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. The Act requires that candidates and committees file campaign statements at periodic intervals.

The Enforcement Division of the Commission has determined that you and your committee, Friends of Barbie Boeger, failed to file a semi-annual campaign statement for the period July 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008, which was due on February 2, 2009.

We have decided to close this case. Your failure to file the required campaign statement is a violation of the Act. (Gov. Code § 84200.) This letter serves as a written warning. The information in this matter will be retained and may be considered should an enforcement action become necessary based on future conduct or newly discovered information.

You must immediately file this campaign statement with the City of Chico.

You are obligated to continue filing campaign statements until you officially terminate your committee. Failure to do so is a violation of the Act. If your committee is no longer active, you may want to terminate your committee at this time as well. Please be advised that after every filing deadline, your local filing officer will refer all non-filers to the Enforcement Division. Any future failure to file your campaign statements will automatically be brought to our attention.

Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act in the future may result in an enforcement action against you, including monetary penalties of up to \$5,000 for each violation.

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Although the Commission is not seeking a penalty in the current matter, you are still responsible for any late filing fees assessed by your filing officer. (Gov. Code § 91013.)


In addition, the filing officer has notified us of her attempt to obtain an amendment to your State of Organization, Form 410, to reflect a change in treasurers. Please note, Section 84103 of the Act, requires an amendment to be filed within 10 days whenever there is a change in any of the information contained in the statement of organization. Therefore, if any changes have occurred that would require an amendment to your statement of organization, then you are required to file an amendment.

If you disagree with our determination that you violated the Act, please contact Teri Rindahl in writing postmarked within 14 days of the date of this letter.

The Commission publishes forms and manuals to facilitate compliance with the provisions of the Act. If you need forms or a manual, or guidance regarding your obligations, please call the Commission's Technical Assistance Division at 1-866-275-3772. Please also visit our website at www.fppc.ca.gov.
