**Re: Warning Letter  
FPPC No. 090098; Rick Anderson**

Dear Mr. Anderson:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act") found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. The Act requires that employees designated in their employer's conflict of interest code file Statements of Economic Interests (Form 700) when they assume office, annually thereafter and within 30 days of leaving their position.

The Commission's Enforcement Division received a non-filer referral from the Commission's Technical Assistance Division on February 19, 2009. On June 8, 2009, the Enforcement Division was notified that you had subsequently filed your 2007 Annual Statement of Economic Interests ("SEI") prior to when the non-filer referral was made.

Instead of requiring payment of penalties as indicated in our letters dated March 11, 2009, and April 8, 2009, alleging that you failed to timely file your 2007 Annual Statement of Economic Interests with the California Travel and Tourism Commission by the April 1, 2008 deadline, regarding your position as a commissioner, we have decided to close this case. Your failure to file the required statement in a timely manner is a violation of the Act. (Section 87300.) While we are not pursuing an administrative penalty in this matter, this letter serves as a written warning. The information in this matter will be retained and may be considered should an enforcement action become necessary based on future conduct or newly discovered information.

Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act in the future may result in an enforcement action against you, including monetary penalties of up to \$5,000 for each violation.


