

1. **Delegate Reimbursements:** These include travel expense reimbursement requests submitted by supervisors to RCRC which have been reimbursed by RCRC for RCRC business.
2. **Paid on Behalf of:** These include travel, meals and other expenses paid directly by RCRC on behalf of supervisors for RCRC business.
3. **Meeting Meals:** These include cost of meals provided by RCRC at meetings and other RCRC events attended.

Because RCRC is not considered a governmental agency for FPPC purposes, the FPPC requires you to report payments from RCRC for meals, travel and lodging expenses associated with your service as an RCRC Board Member Delegate or Alternate Delegate. These expenses are considered "income" for FPPC purposes and not a "gift".

CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

RURAL COUNTIES' ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY

The Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81000, et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict-of-interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (2 Cal. Code of Regs. Sec. 18730) that contains the terms of a standard conflict-of-interest code, which can be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing, the standard code may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference. This regulation, and the attached Appendix designating positions and establishing disclosure requirements, shall constitute the conflict-of-interest code of the **Rural Counties' Environmental Services Joint Powers Authority (Authority)**.

Individuals holding designated positions shall file their statements with the **Authority**, which shall make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction. (Gov. Code Section 81008.) Upon receipt of the statements, the **Authority** shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of the statements to the Fair Political Practices Commission.

Such written determination shall include a description of the duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Executive Director's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code.


