Zhuhai Foreign Affairs Office

Zhuhai served as a corridor for the cultural exchanges between the East and the West in modern Chinese history, and was a pioneer of China's opening-up to the outside world. Zhuhai was the hometown of a number of influential figures that led China's development, including Yung Wing, Tang Tingshu, Chun Afong, Tang Guoan, and Tang Shaoyi. The city has now established sister city relations with 11 cities around the world. It was also in Zhuhai that so many firsts were created, including the first major award for science and high-tech contribution, the first toll processing enterprise in China, the first Sino-foreign joint venture hotel and the first cross-border industrial park of the country. Zhuhai has therefore been a window and experiment field of China's reform and opening-up. The open and inclusive sea culture, the deep-rooted culture of overseas learning, the business-friendly commercial culture and the daring and innovative SEZ culture have constituted the core of the Zhuhai culture.

Zhuhai is also an explorer of coordinated economic development and environmental protection in China. In 1998, Zhuhai stood out from 470 cities around the world to be the first Chinese city to win the Dubai International Award for Best Practices to Improve the Living Environment from UN Habitat. In the report of UN Habitat, Zhuhai was commended as a modernized city with comprehensively improved environment and quality of living through all-round treatment of its environment, a model for other cities in China, and a perfect example of the global efforts to improve human habitat.

Zhuhai Profile

Zhuhai Municipality lies in the south of China, west to the estuary of the Pearl River, bordering Macau on its south and 36 nautical miles west of Hong Kong. Zhuhai is backed by the Pearl River Delta, as well as West Guangdong, and the great hinterland further to the southwest. Facing the Southeast Asian, European and American markets, Zhuhai is an important passageway connecting domestic and international markets. Established in 1953 as a county and 1979 as a city, Zhuhai became one of China's Special Economic Zones (SEZs) in 1980, and enjoys the local legislative right authorized by the National People's Congress. Today's Zhuhai Municipality consists of the three administrative districts of Xiangzhou, Doumen and Jinwan, and the five economic function zones of Hengqin, Gaolan Port, High Tech Zone, Free Trade Zone and Wanshan. Covering a land area of 1724 square kilometers, a sea territory of 5929 square kilometers and a total permanent population of 1.59 million, Zhuhai is the city in the Pearl River Delta with the largest sea territory, largest number of islands and longest coastal line.
