

To the Fair Political Practices Commission In the matter of Kelli Moors FPPC No 13/917.

I am writing as a resident of the City of Carlsbad and parent who had a child in the Carlsbad Unified School District when Ms. Moors was a School Board Trustee. I am appalled we had a school board trustee that violated the trust of the community she served and the 11,000 children that attended Carlsbad Unified School District. Our schools, community, and families teach ethics that Ms. Moors violated.

Ms. Moors violated state law previously by failing to file a semi-annual campaign statement in time for the November 2000 school election and was fined \$1,000. Because of her 12 years on the Carlsbad Unified School District, the amount of time and energy the State of California educates potential and elected state officers and a previous fine, please consider assessing the maximum under the law.

Furthermore, I would hope the Commission way their powers to restrict Ms. Moors from conducting any further business with any public school district in the State of California protecting the children and communities state wide.
