The below property owner signatory acknowledges the public letter submitted by residents re Charles Graces Stipulation and considers this form a signature on that letter:

Summarizing, for brevity here, but not limiting support of the entire content of the letter, the signatory below is a member of the public and owns property in the San Simeon Community Services district that is directly impacted by the Committee's review of the submitted, above-referenced, Stipulation. We write to support the findings in part and to object to them in part. Mainly, we object to the finding that Grace's actions resulted in "No harm to the public." however, we support in material part the remainder of the findings.

It's the opinion of the undersigned property owner in the San Simeon community and the public that the finding of "no harm" to the public resulted from the conflict itself is in error because the Form 700 purpose was completely frustrated by Grace's conduct. The Public reliance upon the attestations in at least ten Form 700's filed by Grace over the years was overtly betrayed.

Therefore, in our opinion, the committee should conclude that harm had come to the public and the 1090 violation caused this harm and should find as such by modifying the Stipulation to so state.
