As it currently stands, rule 18410 would allow anyone to access sensitive financial information that should not be made public. In this age of much higher identity theft and online fraud, releasing this sensitive information will compromise individuals associated with various campaign committees. SB888 was introduced to fix this problem, but unfortunately did not get to the Governor's desk for his signature. I ask that the FPPC delay implementation at this time in order to protect the privacy and financial information of those associated with various campaign committee accounts.
