I am writing to urge the Commission to delay the effective date of the amended Regulation 18410, until redaction is statutorily required on the Form 410. Currently, Form 410 requires the inclusion and submission of sensitive financial information. Under the proposed amended Regulation 18410, committees would be required to include the names of individuals authorized to obtain committee bank records on Form 410. Unless and until the Legislature passes a statute requiring redaction of such sensitive financial information on Form 410, the Commission should hold off on implementation of the Regulation. Adoption now would risk disclosure and potential fraud through theft and misuse of this sensitive information.
