### **Presentations, Workshops and Webinars**

Enforcement Chief Galena West and I made a presentation to an international delegation visiting various state government agencies in the United States. The delegation included more than ten countries and the presentation focused on the FPPC's role and authority to ensure accountability in government. The delegation had also met with legislative staff earlier in the day.

Assistant Division Chief Trish Mayer and Consultant Deborah Hanephin made a presentation to the Central California City Clerks' Association at their annual Nuts and Bolts conference in Modesto regarding campaign and Form 700 filing officer requirements.

Rene Robertson, FPPC's filing officer for state agencies, and Consultant Ivy Branaman conducted an SEI filing officer outreach for the Delta Protection Commission at their office in West Sacramento.

Since my last report, Consultants Courtney Miller and Ivy Branaman conducted a webinar on the process of amending conflict of interest codes for state agencies and Cynthia Fisher and Deborah Hanephin piloted three webinars on the Form 700 process for local filing officers. Over three hundred individuals registered for these webinars.
