(a) Campaign funds raised after January 1, 1989, under the control of a candidate or
elected officer shall will be considered surplus campaign funds on the following dates:
(1) Incumbent Candidates: The <u>90th day after leaving an elective office date on which an</u>
incumbent candidate leaves any elective office for which the campaign funds were raised, or if
the candidate is defeated for reelection, the <u>90th day after the</u> end of the postelection reporting
period following his or her defeat, whichever is later. An incumbent candidate who wishes to use
funds for a future election must transfer those funds to a new committee for a future election no

11 later than this date.

(2) Non-Incumbent Defeated and Withdrawn Candidates: The <u>90th day after the</u> end of
the postelection reporting period following the election in which the candidate was defeated or
from which the candidate withdrew. A <u>defeated</u> non-incumbent candidate <u>who is defeated</u> or
candidate who withdraws from an election who wishes to use funds for a future election must
transfer those funds to a new committee for a future election no later than this date.

(3) Deceased Candidates: Funds belonging to a candidate who dies while in office or
while running for office shall will become surplus the 90th day after the end of the postelection
reporting period on the earlier of either June 30 or December 31 following the candidate's death.
(b) The "end of the postelection reporting period" means June 30 with respect to elections
occurring in the first six months of the calendar year and December 31 for elections occurring in
the latter six months of the calendar year.
