(C) Any other documents necessary to be listed on the ballot as a candidate for any state 18 or local office. 19 20 (3) Payments for services and actual expenses of political consultants, the campaign 21 treasurer and other campaign staff, pollsters and other persons providing services directly in 22 connection with a future election. 23 (4) Payments for voter registration and get-out-the-vote drives.

2	subdivision (a) from either the campaign bank account established pursuant to Government Code
3	Section 85201 for election to the incumbent term of office or from a campaign bank account

5	This section shall not be construed to permit an incumbent elected officer to make expenditures
6	from any campaign bank account for expenses other than those associated with his or her the
