- 6 <u>the defeat, enactment, or outcome of any proposed legislative or administrative action.</u>
- 7 (b) <u>A contract for lobbying services does not, in itself violate Section 86205(f) if it:</u>
- 8 (1) Expressly states the agreed upon terms of compensation to be received in return for
- 9 <u>those lobbying services.</u>
- 10 (2) <u>Provides no discretion to make the agreed upon payment dependent to any degree on</u>
- 11 <u>a specific outcome of the proposed legislative or administrative action for which the lobbying</u>
- 12 <u>services are to be rendered.</u>
