2	§ 18438.8. Disclosure Under Government Code Section 84308.
3	(a) An officer who is required by Government Code section 84308(c) to disclose the
4	receipt of a contribution shall make the disclosure on the public record at the beginning of a
5	public hearing meeting in a proceeding involving the license, permit, or other entitlement for use,
6	if a hearing meeting is held. However, in the circumstance where the officer learns of the
7	contribution during the public meeting, the officer shall make the disclosure on the public record
8	prior to continuing to take part in the proceeding. If there is no public hearing meeting, the
9	disclosure shall be entered into the written record of the proceeding.
10	(b) Any party to a proceeding pending before an agency under Government Code section
11	84308(a) shall disclose on the record of the proceeding the names of any persons whose
12	contributions are required to be aggregated, if the person has made a contribution to any officer
13	of the agency as defined in Government Code section 84308(a)(4). The disclosure shall be made
14	at the time the application is filed, or the proceeding is otherwise commenced, if the contribution
15	was made during the twelve month period preceding the filing of the application or
16	commencement of the proceeding, or no later than 30 days after the contribution is made if the
17	contribution is made at any stage during the proceeding. The party shall make the disclosure:
18	(1) On the date the party files the application or other request initiating the proceeding.
19	(2) For a contribution made at any stage during the proceeding, within 30 days of making
20	the contribution, or the date on which the party makes its first appearance before or
21	communication with the agency regarding the proceeding following the contribution, whichever
22	<u>is earliest.</u>
23	(3) If an agent of a party makes an appearance before or communication with the agency
24	subsequent to the party's disclosure, the party or agent must disclose the agent's identity on the

3 (c) The disclosure shall include the name of the party and any other person making the

- 4 contribution, if any, the name of the recipient, the amount of the contribution, and the date the
- 5 contribution was made.
