## **RESOLUTION NO. 149-2020**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RANCHO CORDOVA. STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION LIMITS FOR THE **ELECTIVE OFFICES OF THE CITY OF RANCHO CORDOVA** 

WHEREAS, in 2019, the state through AB 571 (Mullin) enacted legislation that creates default campaign contribution limits for local elective offices; and

WHEREAS, the default campaign contribution limits, are the limits required of candidates for state Assembly and Senate Offices; and

WHEREAS, AB 571 provides the City the option of enacting its own campaign contribution limits, which also includes the option of adopting a "no-limit" campaign contribution amount: and

WHEREAS, absent the City adopting its own campaign contribution limits, it will be subject to the default campaign contribution limits effective January 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to retain local control over its affairs, to the extent permitted by law, including the ability to regulate campaign contributions for its elective offices; and

WHEREAS, nothing precludes the City from amending its campaign contribution limits at a future date, should it choose to do so.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RANCHO CORDOVA, that there shall be no Campaign Contribution Limit for all elective offices of the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Campaign Contribution Limit may be amended by a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Rancho Cordova.
