

**Fair Political Practices Commission
Filing Schedule For
State Major Donor, State Independent Expenditure and
State General Purpose Recipient Committees Other than Political Party Committees
Senate Districts 1 and 33 Special Primary and General Elections
Being Voted on March 26, 2019 and June 4, 2019 Ballots**

- The 90-day election cycle begins January 16, 2019 for the March 26 Special Primary.
- The 90-day election cycle begins March 6, 2019 for the June 4 Special General.
- Contributions and independent expenditures of \$1,000 or more that are made to or in connection with a candidate being voted on in a special election listed above, or made to a political party committee, must be reported within 24 hours. See Forms 497, 496, and 462 for more information.
- State general purpose recipient committees (other than political party committees), are not required to file regular pre-election statements (Form 460) in connection with the SD 1 and 33 special elections.
