Filing Schedule for Local Slate Mailer Organizations November 2, 2021 Election

Within 24 Hours <i>Late Payment Report</i>	8/4/21 – 11/2/21	498	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> File if a payment of \$2,500 or more is received from a single source to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 2 election. File by personal delivery, e-mail, guaranteed overnight service, or fax. The committee may also file online, if available.
Sep 23, 2021 <i>1st Pre-Election</i>	7/1/21 – 9/18/21	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 2 election.
Oct 21, 2021 <i>2nd Pre-Election</i>	9/19/21 – 10/16/21	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 2 election.
Jan 31, 2022 <i>Semi-Annual</i>	10/17/21 – 12/31/21	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All slate mailer organizations must file this statement.

Additional Notes:

- *** Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Deadline Extensions:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-Hour Late Payment Report (Form 498) that is due the weekend before the election. Such report must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week.
- **Method of Delivery:** All paper filings may be filed by first class mail unless otherwise noted. A paper copy of a report may not be required if a local agency requires online filing pursuant to a local ordinance.
- An SMO receiving payments that are not from the candidate or measure committee listed on the ballot, or payments that are from a third party for the purpose of listing a candidate or measure, should call the FPPC for advice.
