Filing Schedule for Local Slate Mailer Organizations June 7, 2022 Election

File by personal delivery, e-mail, guaranteed overnight service, or fax. The committee may also file online, if available. |
| Apr 28, 2022 <i>1st Pre-Election</i> | 1/1/22 – 4/23/22 | 401 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the June 7 election. |
| May 26 <i>2nd Pre-Election</i> | 4/24/22 – 5/21/22 | 401 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the June 7 election. |
| Aug 1, 2022 <i>Semi-Annual</i> | * – 6/30/22 | 401 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All slate mailer organizations must file this statement. |

Additional Notes:

- ***Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Deadline Extensions:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-Hour Late Payment Report (Form 498) that is due the weekend before the election. Such report must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week.
- **Method of Delivery:** All paper filings may be filed by first class mail unless otherwise noted. A paper copy of a report may not be required if a local agency requires online filing pursuant to a local ordinance.
- An SMO receiving payments that are not from the candidate or measure committee listed on the ballot, or payments that are from a third party for the purpose of listing a candidate or measure, should call the FPPC for advice.
- **Public Documents:** All statements and reports are public documents.
