### Filing Schedule for Local Slate Mailer Organizations November 8, 2022 Election

<b>Aug 1, 2022</b> <i>Semi-Annual</i>	* – 6/30/22	<a href="#">401</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>All slate mailer organizations must file this statement.</li></ul>
<b>Within 24 Hours</b> <i>Late Payment Report</i>	8/10/22 – 11/8/22	<a href="#">498</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>File if a payment of \$2,500 or more is received from a single source to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 8 election.</li><li>File by personal delivery, e-mail, guaranteed overnight service, or fax. The committee may also file online, if available.</li></ul>
<b>Sep 29, 2022</b> <i>1<sup>st</sup> Pre-Election</i>	7/1/22 – 9/24/22	<a href="#">401</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 8 election.</li></ul>
<b>Oct 27, 2022</b> <i>2<sup>nd</sup> Pre-Election</i>	9/25/22 – 10/22/22	<a href="#">401</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer in connection with the November 8 election.</li></ul>
<b>Jan 31, 2023</b> <i>Semi-Annual</i>	* - 12/31/22	<a href="#">401</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>All slate mailer organizations must file this statement.</li></ul>

#### Additional Notes:

- **\*Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Deadline Extensions:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-Hour Late Payment Report (Form 498) that is due the weekend before the election. Such report must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week.
- **Method of Delivery:** All paper filings may be filed by first class mail unless otherwise noted. A paper copy of a report may not be required if a local agency requires online filing pursuant to a local ordinance.
- An SMO receiving payments that are not from the candidate or measure committee listed on the ballot, or payments that are from a third party for the purpose of listing a candidate or measure, should call the FPPC for advice.
- **Public Documents:** All statements and reports are public documents.
