Warning Letter: FPPC No. 15/297; All Green Recycling

Dear Mr. Sadeghi:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a referral received from the Secretary of State that alleged you failed to file a quarterly lobbyist employer report. The Enforcement Division has completed its investigation and found that you failed to file a lobbyist employer report for the period of July 1, 2014 through September 30, 2014.

The Act requires all lobbyist employers to report any activity that occurred during a reporting period.² Lobbyist employers are required to file reports with the Secretary of State's office no later than the end of the month following the reporting period.

Your actions violated the Act because you failed to file a quarterly lobbyist employer report for the period of July 1, 2014 through September 30, 2014 by October 31, 2014. Because your lobbying firm did not report undertaking any activity on your behalf during the period of July 1, 2014 through September 30, 2014, your lobbying firm terminated its relationship with your company retroactive to June 30, 2014, and you have not previously violated the Act, we are closing this matter without further action.

This letter serves as a written warning. The information in this matter will be retained and may be considered should an enforcement action become necessary based on newly discovered information or future conduct. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act in the future will result in monetary penalties of up to \$5,000 for each violation.

A warning letter is an Enforcement Division case resolution without administrative prosecution. This resolution does not provide you with the opportunity for a probable cause hearing or administrative hearing. If you wish to avail yourself of these proceedings by requesting that your case proceed with prosecution rather than a warning, please notify us within ten days
