Hello,

I am an ethics officer who regularly uses the FPPC's website to provide advice to my agency's employees. I have found the new website's search functionality to be a downgrade from the previous version, particularly when looking at advice letters and commission opinions. Specifically, the new website does not properly incorporate Boolean operator search functions. For example, searching the advice letter database for the phrase "real property" no longer searches letters with that exact term but rather any use of "real" or "property" across all advice letters.

Does the commission have any plans to revert the search functionality to its previous version? Thank you.
