

1 Adopt 2 Cal. Code Regs., Section 18420.5 to read:

2 **§ 18420.5. Combined Campaign Reports.**

3 (a) Combined Campaign Report. Pursuant to Section 84205, the Commission may permit,
4 upon request or on their own initiative, candidates and committees to file a combined campaign
5 report when doing so would not reduce or delay the disclosure of required campaign information.

6 (b) Filing Schedule for a Combined Campaign Report. When the Commission permits
7 candidates and committees to file a combined campaign report pursuant to subdivision (a), the
8 Commission shall issue a filing schedule stating the reporting periods and associated due dates.

9 (c) Filing a Combined Campaign Report. Candidates and committees required to file
10 semi-annual and preelection campaign reports, as described in Sections 84200 and 84200.5, are
11 permitted to file a combined campaign report, in lieu of separate reports, when filing pursuant to
12 a Commission-issued filing schedule.

13 (d) Posting. The Commission will post, on the Commission website, each filing schedule
14 created pursuant to this regulation.

15 (e) Notice. The Commission will provide notice and a courtesy copy of a filing schedule
16 for a combined campaign report to the filing officer with whom the relevant candidates and
17 committees are required to file their original campaign report. Failure to provide notice or a
18 courtesy copy to a filing officer does not affect a candidate or committee filing pursuant to a
19 Commission-issued filing schedule.

20 (f) Delegation. The authority to permit the filing of a combined campaign report, as
21 discussed in subdivision (a), and to issue a filing schedule, as discussed in subdivision (b), is
22 delegated to the Commission's Executive Director.

23 (g) Other Filing Obligations. Except as provided in subdivision (c), candidates and
24 committees are subject to all other applicable reporting requirements set out in the Act and its
25 regulations.
