

Amend 2 Cal. Code Regs., Section 18520:

§ 18520. Statement of Intention To Be a Candidate.

(a) For purposes of ~~Government Code section~~ Section 85200, "specific office" means a specific term of "elective office" as defined in ~~Government Code section~~ Section 82023.

(b) Before becoming a candidate for a specific office, and prior ~~Prior~~ to the solicitation or receipt of any contribution or loan for ~~a specific that~~ office, the individual must file a statement, signed under penalty of perjury, of intention to be a candidate for the specific office.

(c) Candidates are not required to file a new statement of intention to be a candidate for the general election or special general election after filing a statement of intention for the connected primary election or special primary election.

(d) A candidate or officeholder who has indicated on their statement of intention that they do not intend to qualify as a committee pursuant to subdivision (b) of Section 85200 need not amend or refile their statement of intention to be a candidate for the duration of their candidacy for that specific office unless they reach the qualification threshold of subdivision (a) of Section 82013. This includes the time period while holding that specific office, should they be successful in the election.
