Dear Mr. Melville:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act¹ (the "Act"). This letter is in response to a referral from the San Mateo County Clerk-Recorder's office alleging that your committee failed to timely file the pre-election campaign statement (Form 460) covering the period of January 1, 2018 through April 21, 2018.

Immediately after being contacted by the Enforcement Division, you contacted the Enforcement Division to explain that you faxed the pre-election campaign statement to the County Clerk-Recorder's office on April 26, 2018, the deadline for the first pre-election statement, and we confirmed this information with the County Clerk-Recorder's office. For that reason, and because you also timely filed your second pre-election campaign statement in connection with the June 5, 2018 election, we are closing this matter without further action.
